Treasurer's Report & Financials as of March 15th

BCT Operating Account - \$160,624; Developer Escrow - \$41,157 (Keyes Crossing road project cost contribution matched by dollar for dollar KFAMA funds); Accounts Receivable - \$99,773; Savings Reserve - \$60,030

Guest comment / questions

 Question about Lakeview lots to be developed – response: escrow funds related to those lots along Lakeview when sold will be released for tar & chip road surfacing expense; also explained delayed progress of Short Drive project waiting on relocation of utility pole

Road Related Issues

- 2023 roads funds \$143,000 current overall amount available for 2023 road care and projects
- 3) **Primary 2023 project** commitment has been made to tar & chip road surfacing starting from Lakeview at end of Short Drive, to Burkett all the way to Renie Dr.
- 4) Short Drive entry decision pending whether to surface with tar & chip or asphalt
- 5) Inbound/outbound lane signage as project nears completion, signs to be installed at each lane indicating inbound and outbound traffic direction
- 6) Speed hump installation at Cedar Hill Dr. quote of \$500 each if speed <u>bumps</u> installed; \$1250 each quoted if speed <u>humps</u> installed; which option still to be determined (\$1500 for three speed <u>bumps</u>; \$3750 for three speed <u>humps</u>)
- 7) Which projects next? potential additional tar & chip surfacing projects at Walnut Hill or Greenwood Rd. contingent on cost expected for road bed and/or roadside prep work (cost of roadwork; stone for road bed and/or to clear or improve shoulder drainage)

Common Areas and Culverts

- 8) Ditch maintenance how much set aside for annual ditch debris clearing \$10K?
- 9) Ditch lining compared Curlex v. straw mat to line recently dug culverts; if only steepest sections lined [2600 linear feet], Curlex would cost \$2K; if lining full length of disturbed culvert [3200 linear feet] = \$2700. Straw mat lining is less expensive = \$800.
- 10) Policy needed discussed recovery of cost to clear trees that fall in easement; best interest of community is to collect as much cost of removal as possible; nearby communities may have similar policy as helpful guideline to be explored

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11) Restricting access to KFA shoreline

- a) Proprietary key at gate lock James to compile 'pledge sheet' of expected behavior to be asked of those accepting a key
- b) Extend cable fencing in shoreline area, longstanding fence has been effective as ATV deterrent; property line needs to be determined (would need to be surveyed) in order to extend fence
- c) Blue Ridge Acres (BRA) collaboration BRA president to be approached about 1) interest in joining us to survey boundary with common goal of managing ATV traffic;
 2) ask if they have established tree removal policy;
 3) ask their recommendation about sufficient stone base (3 inch?) for tar & chip surfacing
